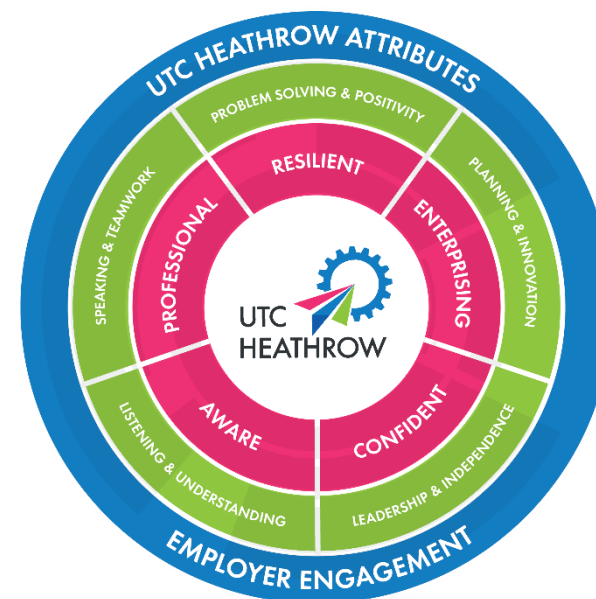
Intent Statement
